Position Purpose:

St. John's is a Pre-K - 8th grade school with a focus on providing a modern education, in part through our 1:1 iPad program, *Imagine*. In support of this program, the Technology Support Specialist will provide Level 1 technical support for the St. John's community. It will require flexibility in his or her schedule and will require occasional support for after school and weekend events.

Expectations:

Primary responsibilities include, but are not limited to:

- Troubleshoot problems with computer systems, including hardware, software, network and peripheral
 equipment
- Support faculty, staff, and student use of PCs and iPads as well as provide ongoing training
- Maintain accurate inventories of all equipment
- Installation of new hardware and software
- Imaging, deployment, and management of PCs and iPads
- Interface with consultants and support companies
- Assist with maintenance and upkeep of network infrastructure
- Provide set up and support for academic performances, special guests and events
- Assist the Technology Department with research and planning for new purchases

Qualifications:

The ideal candidate will have the ability to provide technical support to individuals with a wide range of technological expertise on various platforms in a face-paced environment. Qualifications include:

- Strong knowledge of Windows (Desktop/Server) and iOS platforms
- Experience with Office 365, MDMs, Active Directory a plus
- High degree of technical aptitude
- Excellent communication and people skills
- Excellent research and problem-solving skills
- Understanding of network infrastructures and basic TCP/IP networking
- Comfortable working with adults and children of different skill levels
- Bachelor's Degree, Technical Certification, or equivalent experience preferred
